1. Profile of the University

Sri Krishnadevaraya University had its beginning in the year 1968 as a Post Graduate Centre of Sri Venkateswara University. The Post Graduate Centre was given Autonomy in the year 1976 and was elevated to the status of University in the year 1981. Initially, the University functioned as an Unitary Residential University and was conferred the status of an Affiliating University in the year 1987. The Post Graduate Centre at Kurnool till then functioning under the aegis of Sri Venkateswara University was brought under the jurisdiction of this University in the year 1993 and the Centre was elevated to the status of an Unitary Residential University in 2008.

The University College offers 37 post graduate and 2 under graduate courses through 29 departments. The University College of Engineering and Technology has been offering three engineering branches since 2006-07. The University College of Education was started in the academic year 2007-08, which offers B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses. The University College of Pharmacy was started from the academic year 2008-09.

Sri Krishnadevaraya University has been contributing to the cause of higher education through 111 affiliated degree colleges of which 11 are meant exclusively for women. The other colleges affiliated to the University include 51 Colleges of Education, two Oriental Colleges, three Law Colleges and one Engineering College while 38 affiliated colleges under the University are also offering postgraduate courses in various disciplines.

Sri Krishnadevaraya University has facilities for undertaking study and research through well established library and laboratories. The students, besides the opportunities for academic advancement, are provided with facilities such as outdoor stadium, playgrounds, gymnasium, E-Class Room, INFLIBNET, Internet and computer networks for their overall personality development. The infrastructure of the University also includes Bhuvana Vijayam Auditorium, Sabari Guest House, Health Centre, Adhyapak Bhavan, NSS Building, Janmabhoomi Canteen and several buildings for teaching departments and residential quarters.

Sri Krishnadevaraya University also functions as one of the centres for On-line counseling of ICET, LAW CET and EdCET candidates for admission into different Universities and affiliated colleges.

Sri Krishnadevaraya University gained recognition as a centre of academic excellence, as it was accorded a four star status by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council.

2. The Centre for Distance Education

Sri Krishnadevaraya University established the Centre for Distance Education (CDE) in the academic year 2000-01 with the introduction of

the post-graduate courses under distance mode for the benefit of those who could not pursue education under regular mode. It aims at providing higher education to large sections of the population, particularly to the disadvantaged sections of the society. The Centre offers various academic programmes that lead to certificates, Diplomas and Under Graduate, Post Graduate, M.Phil. and Ph.D. Degrees. The undergraduate courses B.A. and B.Com were introduced in the academic year 2005-06. At present the CDE is offering B.A., B.Sc., B.Com (Gen), B.Com (Computers), B.L.I.Sc and B.Ed. The Post-graduate courses offered by the Centre include M.A. in English, Telugu, History, Economics, Political Science, Sociology; Rural Development; M.Sc. in Mathematics, Botany, Organic Chemistry, Physics, Zoology; Computer Science, Electronics and Communications, Electronics and Instrumentation, M.Com., M.B.A., M.C.A.; P.G. Diploma courses in Business Administration, Marketing Management, Insurance Management, Computer applications, Mass Communications and Journalism, e-Commerce and Human Rights and Values education.

6. How to get the Application and Prospectus:

7. How to Apply

The applicants are advised to go through the Prospectus carefully before filling the application form and mention clearly the course and the subject for which they want to apply.

Instructions for filling up the Application Form

- (a) The entries in the application should be filled in carefully by the applicants in their own handwriting which should be legible. Typed entries will not be accepted.
- (b) Mention the course and subject clearly.
- (c) Course fee specified in Item 5 by way of enclosing the counterfoil of On-line transfer or a Demand Draft (see page vi for mode of payment). These details should be furnished in the relevant column of the application. Postal orders, Money orders, Mail transfers, Challans and cash payment will not be accepted.
- (d) Details of the Original Certificates submitted along with the application should be furnished in the relevant column of the application.
- (e) One recent photograph of passport size attested by a Gazetted officer should be pasted on the application form in the space provided for it.

8. Admission Procedure:

Eligible candidates will be given the admission after scrutiny of the original certificates, counterfoil of On-line transfer/Demand Draft pertaining to the Admission fee etc. enclosed with the application(see page vi for mode of payment). Admission is open to all those who have the prescribed qualifications. Candidates selected for admission will receive the admission intimation cards by post.

Note 1: The application will be summarily rejected if there is any discrepancy between the information in the application and the supporting documents.

Note 2: When the candidate is declared eligible for admission, the fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Note 3: If a candidate is not selected for admission, the admission fee (enclosed along with application) and original certificates will be returned.

Note 4: Admission can not be claimed as a matter of right. If the adequate number of candidates are not enrolled for any particular course, the University reserves the right to withdraw that course. In such case, the course fee and other certificates will be returned.

Returning of Originals:

The original pass certificates and the statement of Marks will be returned to the candidates after scrutiny and finalization of admission along with Admission Memo. Candidates should enclose a self addressed envelope duly stamped (Rs.35/-) for returning the original certificates.

9. Enrolment Number and Identity Card:

The Directorate will issue an **Identity Card** and assign an **Enrolment Number** to each admitted candidate. The candidates are instructed to keep their Identity Card safely till the completion of the course and must bring their Identity Card at the time of Personal Contact Programme and during all the Examinations. For all correspondence, the Enrolment Number should be invariably mentioned.

Candidates who have lost their Identity Card can obtain a duplicate Identity Card from the CDE by submitting counterfoil of On-line transfer or a Demand Draft for Rs.50/- along with a requisition and stamp size photograph(see page vi for mode of payment).

10. Study Material:

The CDE will send the Study Material by post to the admitted candidates along with the syllabus of the course.

Note: The study material will be issued on the spot for those who have paid course fee.

11. Study Centres – Courses Offered:

The Personal Contact Programmes for M.A., M.Sc., M.Com., M.B.A., P.G. Diploma and B.L.I.Sc. courses will be conducted in the University departments/departments of affiliated colleges offering the courses. Apart from theory classes, practical classes will also be held in the respective departments of the University/affiliated colleges for M.Sc. courses (except for Mathematics).

The courses – M.C.A., M.Sc. Computer Science and P.G. Diploma in Computer Science require laboratory training and continuous interaction with the teachers. There will be a project work and Viva-voce at every year end of the course. Therefore, the admitted

candidates of these courses are attached to the Study centers chosen by them at the time of applying.

The contact classes will be conducted regularly at the Study centres. Each theory paper will be taught for 45 hours and laboratory for 40 hours. The weekend classes will be held at the Study Centres on Sundays and public holidays. The Study Centre will provide the required information from time to time. It provides academic counselling apart from arranging the week-end classes. The applicant

can indicate three Study Centres in the order of preference in the application form. The CDE will allocate one of them. Before selecting a study centre, the applicants are advised to contact the Study Centre about the availability of a particular course in that Centre. If the required number of candidates are not there, the study centre of next order of preference will be allocated. In the allocation of the Centres, if adequate number of candidates are not enrolled in any of the centres indicated, the CDE will allot the nearest Study centre to the candidates. The CDE will not entertain any change in the Study centre subsequently.

The schedule of the Contact Programme will be available at the Study Centre. Expert lectures also will be arranged now and then on week ends.

12. Assignments:

There is an internal assessment in the evaluation of candidate's performance under distance education programmes. The Assignment carries 25 Marks (30 Marks for M.B.A.) in each paper for all the courses. Assignment question papers will be sent to all the candidates admitted. Submission of the assignments response sheet is compulsory and will be reckoned for internal assessment marks for all courses. Candidates have to secure a minimum score as prescribed. Candidates who fail to submit the assignment response sheets within the prescribed time will forfeit the internal assessment marks and automatically fail in the examinations. The answers to the assignments should be handwritten by the candidates. The assignments should be answered by the candidates on good quality A4 size papers and submitted to the Director, CDE as per the schedule. **Typewritten / Photocopy / Computer printout response sheets will not be accepted.**

Assignments should be submitted paper wise through a registered post. The CDE has made a facility to issue acknowledgement for the receipt of assignment. The candidates are informed to send a self addressed stamped envelop worth of Rs.6/- for acknowledgement. The candidate has to ensure that the assignments are received within the prescribed time. The CDE is not responsible for any postal delays/lapses.

13. Personal Contact Programme:

The Personal Contact Programme (PCP) is designed to help the learners with classroom counselling to cover the important and difficult topics of the syllabus. The lectures will be arranged for selected topics. The candidates can interact with the teachers and seek clarifications on the subject.

Personal Contact Programme Classes for all the courses during the First year will be conducted for six days for all Arts and M.Sc. Mathematics. One month for all the courses of Sciences.

For Second / Third year, the PCP classes will be held for a week (Arts & Social Sciences) and one month for all Science Courses.

75% attendance for PCP classes is compulsory for all Science Courses. Those who fail to fulfil the required attendance will not be allowed for the examinations

The schedule of the Contact Programme will be communicated later.

The candidates should make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging for attending the PCP classes.

14. Examinations Information:

Registration for the Examinations

There will be a University Examination at the year end of each course.

The candidates appearing for I/II/III year regular examinations need not pay the Examination fee since the examination fee is collected along with the Course fee. However, every candidate has to register through the prescribed Examination Application Form within the prescribed time for the First/Second/Third Year examination soon after he / she becomes eligible to appear for it.

Application forms for the examinations along with fee particulars will be sent to all the candidates who have paid their course fee in full, well

in advance of the examination schedule. The Hall-Ticket number will be the same as Enrolment number.

If the candidate fails to do so, he / she can appear for the examination subsequently within the stipulated duration **on payment of the prescribed examination fee.**

The candidates appearing for the improvement examinations must pay the prescribed Fee and register for the examination through the prescribed Examination Application form.

There is no detention system in distance education. Candidates who have failed in any year will be allowed to continue the course of study for the next year.

Examination Applications will not be sent to those who wish to write backlog papers/improvement examinations.

The Examination Application Forms must be collected either from the CDE office or can be down loaded from the CDE website: www.skucde.com.

The Hall Tickets will be sent directly to the candidates by post. The venue of the Examination Centre will be indicated on the Hall-Ticket.

Those who do not receive the Hall Ticket by post have to approach the Chief Superintendent of the Examination Centre with a counterfoil of On-line transfer/Demand draft for Rs.100/-, two pass port size photographs and the identity card for obtaining the duplicate Hall ticket (see page vi for mode of payment).

The University Examination consists of two components – External and Internal. The External and Internal Examinations carry 75 marks (70 for M.B.A) and 25 marks (30 for M.B.A) marks respectively.

The **Internal Examinations** constitute the assessment of assignments answered by the candidates. **External Examinations** will be held at the year end for all the courses.

A candidate has to secure 35 marks to pass in any paper. The maximum marks for the examination for each paper is 100, out of which internal assessment carries 25 marks (20 for M.B.A) and external examination 75 marks (70 for M.B.A). The internal marks are the marks allotted for assignments (response sheets). The candidate should secure at least 26 marks (25 for M.B.A) in the external examination and 9 marks (10 for M.B.A) in the internal assessment to pass an examination. However, the candidate has to secure an aggregate of 40% of marks on the whole to be declared to have passed the Whole Examination.

Candidates may reappear for the failed papers in subsequent examinations and pass in those papers. They should complete the course during the maximum period of the validity of their registration.

Candidates who do not secure minimum marks in external examination in a paper should reappear for the external examination of that paper as and when it is held and obtain at least the passing minimum, 26 marks (25 for M.B.A).

Candidates who do not secure minimum marks in the internal assessment of a paper should submit the assignment /internal assessment of that paper within three months from the date of Publication of results of the respective examinations. Only three successive chances from the date of registration will be given to candidates for securing minimum marks in the assignments, irrespective of whether they avail themselves of the chances or not.

Candidates, who have completed their grace period of three years for submission of assignments, may submit their assignments before the end of the third year with a penal fee of Rs.50/- per assignment.

Revaluation:

There is a provision for revaluation of paper/s as per the University rules on payment of the fee prescribed by the CDE. Those who wish to have revaluation of the paper/s have to apply with in 21 days from the date of the publication of the results. After expiry of this date, the request will not be considered.

Award of Class for Successful Candidates

Successful candidates will be awarded class on the basis of the total marks obtained by them in the first, second and third year examinations taken together as described below.

First class with Distinction will be awarded to those who obtain not less than 70% of the total marks. First class will be awarded to those who obtain 60% of marks and above and below 70% of the total marks.

Second class will be awarded to those who obtain 50% of marks and above and below 60%.

Third class shall be awarded to the rest of the successful candidates obtaining a minimum of 40% of marks as specified.

Note: Candidates who wish to appear for improvement of class should not apply for the Provisional / Original Degree Certificates
